RUTHIES INLAWS posted the early fractions, drew well clear into midstretch and weakened in the drive while best of the others. VERDIA lacked the needed late response. INNSBRUCK raced outside into the stretch and offered little in the drive. FIESTY FOE saved ground and lacked a rally. PRETTY LILLY pressed the early issue and tired through the lane. SILKY CONDUCTION broke in some then showed little.
