NO MO BAMBINO set a pressured pace and held on gamely. DESERT PARADISE broke a bit awkwardly, rallied four wide on the turn, closed steadily and gained late. SPRING CALL pressed the pace four across, challenged for the lead on the turn, dueled past the eighth pole and weakened. BLUE 'EM AWAY (IRE) pressed the pace three across, fell back on the turn and finished evenly. DESERT TRAIN dueled between horses, had the rider check entering the turn and dropped back. COZY BAR raced inside, got through along the rail entering the turn and lacked a bid. SPOT OF TROUBLE distanced the field.
