Footnotes

BLAST'EM held a good position, rallied inside on the second turn, eased out, swung a bit wide entering the stretch, assumed command mid stretch and drew off. KEEP ME POSTED pressed the pace inside, assumed command along the backstretch, drew clear on the turn, led to mid stretch but was outclosed to finish second best. RHYTHM IN MAY was unhurried early, bid ten wide at the top of the lane and got up for show while no threat to the top two. TOMMY AND BUSTER set a pressured pace while racing well off the rail, fell back a bit on the backstretch, bore out on the second turn, lost ground and finished evenly. GIVAJUNIOR MINT lagged early, went eight wide in the drive and lacked a rally. TOCCT'S CHARM saved ground, lacked a bid and was outrun. WILLIE PREVAIL pressed the pace while racing in hand, was carried out on the turn, angled in and gave way.
