KENTUCKY WALTZ pressed the pace, got a head in front on the far turn, drew away for a clear lead and held under urging. ALONG CAME JONES was crowded at the start, was boxed in along the rail to the upper stretch and closed once clear. CANT CATCH JUDY stalked the pace while racing inside, eased out for the drive and got up for show. GERIFIC was unhurried early, went widest in the drive and finished well. PRESENTEE raced close to the pace, rallied three wide on the far turn, leveled off in the drive and fell back. PEPE LE FEU rallied four wide on the second turn to loom a threat, hung late and dropped back. MISS NUCAY failed to threaten in an even effort. BRAVE J. LO set the pace to the second turn and weakened in the drive.
