EVENING ISLAND was unhurried early, bid six wide at the top of the stretch, closed steadily to wear down his rivals and got up in the final strides. SURPLUS vied inside, inched away in the upper stretch, led to deep stretch and was caught despite steady urging. THOMAS BAINES vied well off the rail, went five wide at the top of the stretch, went willingly to the wire but didn't have enough late. MR. CACHT (ARG) stalked the pace, went four wide entering the stretch and lacked the needed late response. AZ RIDGE was never far off the pace, lacked a rally and did not threaten. ST PATRICKS APPEAL stalked inside, bid along the rail on the turn and hung in the lane. LAKE SAWYER trailed the field.
