CAMP VERDE raced mid pack, rallied three across on the far turn, dueled past the eighth pole and drew off under urging. SURF CITY BRAT chased the pace, rallied around the turn to challenge between horses, dueled past the eighth pole but was no match late. VALID THOUGHTS saved ground mid pack, rallied along the rail into the second turn, was blocked through the upper stretch, angled out and closed. CHACO D was void of early speed, offered a mild late rally five wide and improved position. DECARCHY FEVER was sent to the front to set the pace with a clear lead, responded when challenged on the turn, dueled past the eighth pole and tired. AMBEKAY was not a factor. BRAZILIANO was through early and faded from contention.
