Footnotes

ENGINEER vied along the rail to the turn, drew off and extended his lead while being ridden out. SEDONA SLICK stalked the pace, couldn't gain on the winner but earned place under steady urging. EDMOND vied between horses to the turn, fell back, hung late but held safely for show. TAT STRIDER pressed the pace while racing three across to the turn, fell back and lacked a late rally. AFFIRMIA stalked inside, got through along the rail on the turn to get within striking distance and came up empty. DE SICA fell far back early, saved ground to the stretch and lacked a bid. ROZYS SCENARIO was rank at the start, fell far back and was not urged late.
