C S I IOWA was unhurried early, angled out entering the second turn, bid five wide entering the stretch, closed willingly and drew clear late. SAX challenged for the lead on the second turn, got a head in front near the eighth pole, was outclosed and just lasted for second. KENTUCKY MILE was unhurried early, couldn't get through along the rail on the second turn, angled out in the upper stretch, closed fast once clear and just missed for place. JUST JEBICAH was away well, dropped inside to stalk, bid willingly but didn't have enough late. YACHT SPOTTER assumed command on the first turn, drew clear, weakened in the drive and lost position. RAN RAN RAN was in tight quarters entering the first turn, raced mid pack and lacked a bid. DARL'S GEM was in tight quarters entering the first turn, raced close to the pace outside, had nothing left for the drive and faded through the stretch.
