Footnotes

EMERALD'S DIAMOND lagged while racing outside, went seven wide at the top of the lane, closed steadily and got up near the wire. CIERA BAY was steadied at the start, saved ground to the stretch, angled out to bid six wide, closed well and was outfinished in a game effort. CASSIE WILL DO IT bumped and was squeezed at the start, vied two across, inched away past the eighth pole, led late and was outclosed. SHELBYLICIOUS bobbled and bumped at the start, stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, bid willingly to threaten but didn't have enough late. REORDER bobbled and bumped at the start, vied past the eighth pole and faltered.
