THE BARTON BOY set the pace, responded to pressure on the turn, inched clear and held well in a driving finish. MIDLAND EMPIRE was unhurried mid pack, rallied four wide on the turn, couldn't gain on the winner and finished second best. KAFWAIN SECRET M D was steadied into the first turn, trailed the field, rallied around the second turn, bid six wide and was along for show. MIGHTY BUCK was never far off the pace, went five wide at the top of the lane, was steadied briefly mid stretch and lacked a late rally. WIN FOR ANNIE DEAR improved position in an even effort. TIGHT END saved ground, got through along the rail on the turn, bid and came up empty. I'M THE GOLD stalked the pace, challenged for the lead on the second turn and gave way.
