GOIN' DANCIN stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, vied through the stretch and proved best. LORD AVALON broke awkwardly, raced close to the pace inside, awaited room on the turn and in the upper stretch, got through along the rail, dueled for the lead and was outfinished. JUST JEBICAH set a pressured pace to late stretch and was outclosed. KINGSVILLE raced mid pack, went five wide on the turn, drifted out in the drive and didn't have enough late. TRIFECTA PHIL pressed the pace to the upper stretch and weakened in the drive. GRANDEST SLAM vied along the rail early, appeared to be trying to get out and was taken back and bore out on the turn to race wide. PRINCIPLE SECRET stumbled at the start and trailed in a wide trip.
