SOUL DIGGER up close early, raced in the three path for the stretch run and finished gamely while prevailing at the wire. NAUGHTICAL (GB) four wide early then in the three path into the far turn, moved to the front between calls on the final turn, battled through the lane and regained a narrow advantage nearing the wire then just missed. JUDOBABY broke a bit slowly then moved up quickly between rivals to set the pace, saved ground and was headed on the final turn, battled back through the stretch run then yielded grudgingly while drifting in late. SUAVESGIRL raced along the inside turning for home and lacked the needed rally. NUBIAN PRINCESS raced in the four path entering the lane and lacked a rally. AMOKITTEN tried to get out some heading into the clubhouse turn while inside, saved ground and raced forwardly placed into the far turn and weakened. MAMIE DOUD broke slowly, pressed on the backstretch and weakened on the final turn.
