HEBESMALLBUTMIGHTY hung five wide into the clubhouse turn, raced well placed and challenged for the lead into the lane then finished steadily while being ridden out. SUNSET KID gradually advanced on the final turn, raced in the three path into the lane and finished gamely for the place. POWER STATION saved ground into the far turn, was four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. REIGN OF THE EDGE bothered some heading into the clubhouse turn, raced along the inside into the stretch then finished willingly between rivals. HONEST EARNIE set the pace inside and weakened late. SCRIMMAGE raced five wide nearing the lane and lacked a rally. A STAR FOR US prompted the early issue and tired in the drive. ARIZONA PROSPECT away slowly moved up early while headstrong and was checked in traffic into the first turn, raced outside thereafter and gradually weakened after a half.
