ICETOANESKIMO rallied five wide entering the stretch, dueled past the sixteenth pole and drew clear. LOTS OF CASH vied two across to the turn, drew clear, responded when challenged, dueled to deep stretch but was no match late. REDDY GO JAYLO bumped at the start, was slow early, went five wide entering the stretch, offered a mild bid only and was along for show. JIMINI CHRISTMAS was never far off the pace, put in an even effort and lacked a bid. LONDYN PEYTON bumped at the start and was outrun in a wide trip. OFFICER LUSK was not a factor. MISS MAGNABILITY drew clear early, vied along the rail to the turn, dropped back and faded through the stretch. TRU TUDI saved ground, lacked a stretch response and dropped back steadily.
