MAD ABOUT FUZZ prompted the early issue, saved ground and vied for the lead on the turn, drew clear in the stretch then held to the wire. DARK VADER broke a bit slowly, advanced outside on the turn, was bumped turning for home then finished willingly. YES HE'S A PISTOL saved ground into the turn, raced three wide into the lane and gradually gained ground. CLAY W. WOODSTOCK forwardly placed early, gradually lost position on the turn, was four wide into the lane and gained some late. PATRIATE showed the early way, raced just off the inside on the turn and vied for command then weakened in the drive. ANGELIC FIDDLER near the rail on the turn, bumped with a rival turning for home and lacked the needed bid. BARRAMOON raced along the inside through the lane and lacked a rally.
