Footnotes

TRIBAL DREAMS stalked inside, bid along the rail entering the stretch, assumed command with a short lead and held under steady urging. TWO VIOLINS set a pressured pace, bore out leaving the turn, lost ground, continued willingly but couldn't gain. STORMIN PROUD PAPA was never far off the pace, went three wide entering the stretch and got up for show. HOLY BUCKETS vied two across, was carried out leaving the turn, fell back and was outfinished for third. FIRST TIME JOHN broke slowly, saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn to get within striking distance and hung. CROWN KING was never far off the pace while racing outside, went five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. YES TALK TO ME stalked to the turn and gave way.
