IF IT STAYS FAIR raced in the back, went six wide leaving the turn, closed willingly and got up late in a driving finish. TWO TURNS was never far off the pace, challenged five wide on the second turn, dueled past the eighth pole, inched away for a short lead, led to deep stretch and was outclosed. DARL'S GEM moved up between horses along the backstretch, vied to mid stretch but was unable to sustain his bid. KINGSVILLE set the pace around the first turn, fell back to stalk inside, awaited room on the turn, bid inside to loom a threat and hung. THREE PARK NIGHT trailed the field, advanced along the rail on the turn and failed to rally. BRAZILIAN SLEWS moved up three across along the backstretch, vied to the second turn, tired and gave way. COLD SURF bobbed at the start, was hustled along, was through after a half and steadily dropped back.
