VICTORY AFFAIR vied between horses, fell back into the turn, rallied three wide entering the stretch and drew off past the eighth pole while kept to task. DARN THAT ALEYNA was always within striking distance and was up late for place. BABE WITH ATTITUDE bumped at the start, three wide to the turn, dueled to the eighth pole and weakened. DRAG TIME GAL carried out a bit at the start and improved her position. SHE'S SO SHARP dueled inside past the eighth pole and faltered. SHAWNEE SECRET ducked out a bit at the start and failed to menace. NAEVUS WHO raced midpack and lacked a rally. NEW RIVER BELLE bumped at the start and did not threaten. COMPATABLE ducked in after the start and never reached contention.
