CORNROW WALEASE broke sharply, set the pace with a clear lead and held well under steady urging. CHUMASH JOE raced mid pack outside, went four wide entering the stretch, closed well to narrow the gap and got up for second. IRONSIDES chased the pace, gained late in a steady effort and was outfinished for place. TOMMY'S TREASURE saved ground, bid along the rail but didn't have enough late. FOREIGN EXCHANGE failed to menace in an even effort. CHAILEPIS raced between horses, lacked a rally and did not threaten. BABY FISH was hustled along to show brief speed, dropped back and trailed.
