SO GONE raced two across, dueled throughout, shied from the whip, drifting out under left handed urging in the stretch drive and was outfinished in a game effort. SO WHATABOUT held a good position, lacked the needed late response and prevailed for show. NOT OPPOSED raced close to the pace inside, bid through traffic, lacked room late and was outfinished for third. CLAY W. WOODSTOCK was never far back, bid six wide and closed steadily to narrow the gap. PARTNERSHIP PAYOUT broke slowly, was unhurried early, went seven wide in the drive and offered a mild bid only. BITTER CREEK put in an even effort and failed to threaten. ICE PARK raced outside, lacked a rally and was outrun. WALLEYE JOE broke awkwardly, saved ground and lacked a bid.
