Footnotes

STRATEGIST stalked the pace, rallied four wide on the turn, got a head in front and drew off past the eighth pole under steady urging. T C CASH MAN vied inside past the eighth pole, couldn't keep up and was no match for the winner. AGGRESSION raced close to the pace while racing inside, eased out for the drive, bid and hung. PACE TO BURN angled out entering the turn, swung wide entering the stretch and offered a mild bid once straightened. DARK INTRIGUE raced five wide to the turn, dropped inside and lacked the needed late rally. DISMISS THE LOT vied between horses to the stretch, weakened and faded from contention. TURNING TIGER vied three across to the turn and gave way. The rider of DISMISS THE LOT lodged an objection for alleged interference near the three eighths pole. No change was made.
