STRATEGIST was unhurried early while saving ground, angled out on the far turn, rallied through traffic, dueled late and proved best. LITTLE DUANIE chased the pace, challenged for the lead three across at the top of the lane, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished in a good effort. BANKER'S D LIGHT was never far off the pace, bid six wide, closed steadily and gained late. COLD PRINCE was hustled along to vie two across and faltered near the sixteenth pole. MOTEADO lagged early, went seven wide in the drive and offered a mild bid only. DAY WITH DESI vied inside to the upper stretch, weakened and faded. HAVIN A GOOD DAY raced mid pack, advanced inside on the far turn, stopped and was not urged late. AUTOCUE (GB) trailed far back, was never in contention and was vanned off.
