Footnotes

SKYSPY drew clear early and drew off to a long lead down the backstretch, showed the way to the lane and remained well clear under intermittent urging. ONE'S OWN ACCORD saved ground to the stretch and finished steadily for the place. SHRYOCK saved ground into the far turn, raced off the inside into the lane and lacked the needed late response. BONBONI three wide on the clubhouse turn, was brushed entering the lane shifting to the five path then offered a mild response. PROGRAM MANAGER trailed and near the rail turning for home, raced inside through the final furlong and lacked the needed late response. VICTORY CHECK tracked early inside, raced between rivals turning for home and in the four path entering the lane and lacked the needed bid. EPICURUS lodged a bid on the final turn, chased and drifted out some into the lane and weakened. MEDICINE CREEK three deep on the clubhouse turn, raced five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. OLYMPIC CHIEF raced forwardly placed early and weakened on the final turn.
