GLEAM OF HOPE pressed the pace, closed willingly, assumed command near the sixteenth pole, inched clear and held well in a driving finish. SEVEN TUFF was unhurried early, angled out at the top of the stretch, bid eight wide, found his best stride late and was gaining fast. SARATOGA BOOT was never far off the pace, eased out leaving the turn, bid five wide and closed steadily to earn show. JAIVAL raced close to the pace inside, got through along the rail on the second turn, bid gamely to threaten but didn't have enough late. EVENING ISLAND lagged early, went seven wide leaving the turn and went willingly to the wire. ADRIATIC MOON pressed the pace, went six wide into the stretch, bid willingly, was crowded late and fell back. BEER MEISTER was slow early, angled out in the upper stretch and closed well while wide. QUIET AGAIN was pulled up and vanned off. FRANSOR'S FINEST showed speed to the second turn, tired and stopped.
