EXPLOITITRIGHT dueled on the lead to the stretch, took a clear lead in upper stretch then ducked out sharply approaching the furlong marker, was straightened and drove clear late. SOFT SEVENTEEN broke slowly then rushed up into contention down the backstretch, loomed a solid threat to the winner in upper stretch then couldn't match strides the final furlong. DANCING FLYER raced four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch, then lacked a solid bid. JAKER dueled outside the winner to the stretch then weakened. IT'S NOT OVER YET held a good position into the turn, lodged a three-deep bid nearing the quarter pole then tired through the drive. BREAKOUT POWER was a bit rank after the start leaving the chute, moved inside into the turn, stayed inside for the drive and never threatened. TONY'S ODYSSEY saved ground to no avail. ZAGGER raced green leaving the chute after the start, dropped back into the turn and never threatened.
