DECATUR was three deep near the pace while between foes in the run to the turn, lodged her bid from between rivals nearing the stretch, opened a clear lead a furlong out and held safe a late challenger. BITTERBUTSWEET was bothered just after the start then moved to the rail and moved into a contending position into the turn, took the three path on the turn into the stretch, altered to the rail a sixteenth out and finished well. KYLIE'S WAY came out some at the start then held a good position into the turn, was four wide into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. MISS DOW JONES was four deep near the pace into the turn, lodged her bid nearing the stretch to reach the leaders then weakened late. FEMMINA FANTASTICA vied for the lead from between foes, remained a contender to mid-stretch then weakened. DERRY was hung four wide into the turn, came six wide into the stretch and never seriously threatened. FORBIDDEN BLISS was three deep between foes in the second flight into the turn, was through after a half and tired in the drive. DON'T TELL DADDY set the early pace, vied for the lead into the drive and tired.
