PURSUXIT pressed the pace to the turn, assumed command, drew off for a clear lead, was under steady urging and drifted out a bit late. MCGILLIVRAY LAKE bobbed a bit at the start, raced outside, went nine wide in the drive and finished well. GAMBLER BILL raced five wide to the turn, pressed the pace, challenged for the lead on the turn, hung in the lane and held safely for show. GRAN PETER fell far back early, angled out at the top of the stretch and offered a mild bid only while seven wide. NOBLE CAVALIER raced close to the pace inside, had little left for the drive and hung. COOPER'S STORM failed to threaten in an even effort. CHAPEL IN THE PARK pressed the pace while racing along the rail, was boxed in on the turn, steadied while waiting for room and gave way. GETAWAY PANCHO set a pressured pace to the turn and stopped.
