MY BLUE RIBBON raced three deep on the turn and vied for the lead, drifted some briefly turning for home, edged clear passing the eighth pole then was hand urged. GOOD MANGO three wide into the turn, raced five wide into the stretch and closed well late. GIACOMO GIRL saved ground to the lane, advanced along the rail into midstretch and continued on willingly while needing a bit more. QUALITY TOCS vied for the lead between rivals and weakened in the drive. MAGGIEREDVANENTUNE chased outside, raced four wide into the lane and tired. LIL SHYANNE pressed the early issue inside, vied for the lead entering the lane then weakened in the drive. LET'S DO THIS raced near the rail and lacked the needed response. TASTE THE WILD trailed and lacked a rally.
