**Footnotes**

CONGRATS SKI was never far off the pace, advanced along the rail into the turn, eased out for the drive, challenged for the lead into the stretch, drew off past the eighth pole and held safely under urging. MARK OF MISCHIEF lagged early, bid five wide into the stretch, closed steadily and gained late to earn place. LOOKN MIGHTY TUFF was unhurried early and raced in the back, went eight wide at the top of the stretch and finished well to get up for show. SERGE TO PARADISE raced close to the pace inside, angled out on the second turn, bid eight wide but didn't have enough late. MR SHANE THE PAIN was unhurried early, saved ground to the stretch and offered a mild bid only. TEMPLE OF GOLD pressed the pace, assumed command along the backstretch, raced well off the rail, swung seven wide leaving the turn and tired in the drive. WED TOO QUICK raced in the middle of the pack in an even effort and lacked a bid. JULY RUNNER was never far back, got through along the rail on the turn and lacked a response. BEAR CREEK ROAD set the pace around the first turn, stalked to the second turn, tired and gave way. FOLLOW THROUGH was through after a half and was not urged through the stretch.
