ZYNASTRY rank briefly leaving the gate, saved ground turning for home, eased out and closed well. CRAZY LARRYS just off the rail on the turn, finished well outside. PIRATE'S FLEET close up and in the two path on the turn, challenged for the lead during the stretch run then was outfinished. DUN RINGILL vied for the early lead, drew clear and saved ground then weakened in the drive. DOTTED SWISS lacked a response. RINGGOLD GAP vied for the early lead, raced outside and had little left entering the stretch.
