PIVOT PAD showed the way to the lane, drifted out through the stretch run and drew out late under hand urging. FREE ACTION stumbled at the start, lodged a bid on the turn then finished willingly while second best. HALO'S LAW prompted the early issue, moved closer nearing the top of the lane then weakened in the drive. AL GHAZI'S PENNY forwardly placed and outside on the turn, raced four wide into the lane and lacked the needed stretch response. DR. POOH steadied slightly at the start, was outrun to the lane and lacked a rally. LIZ'S PIRATE chased and weakened in the drive. ALMOST SUMMER chased early and weakened on the turn. COVER CHARGER saved ground and lacked a response.
