Footnotes

FAST TRACK near the inside into the far turn, raced in the three path entering the lane and proved best to the wire. RELATORRE saved ground and moved to the front on the backstretch, drew clear in the lane then held on willingly while unable to contain the top one. CHACO D never far back, saved ground and lacked the needed late response. VALID THOUGHTS just off the inside on the clubhouse turn, prompted the issue, chased through the lane and weakened late. JAZZMAN'S DANCE moved up between rivals on the backstretch, raced three wide into the far turn and tired. SURF CITY BRAT four wide on the clubhouse, pressed the issue, moved inside on the final turn and weakened. VINDICATE IT set the early pace and raced off the rail on the clubhouse turn while inside of rivals, got out and raced wide into the far turn and was eased.
