TALK CIRCUIT hustled early, drew clear on the turn and widened into midstretch then maintained a safe margin. I WANNA GO FAST raced between rivals approaching the quarter pole, moved out and brushed with a foe nearing the eighth pole then finished steadily for the place. WHITE SPAR raced four wide on the turn, was brushed nearing the furlong marker and needed more late. JUST JEBICAH trailed and five wide into the stretch, offered a mild late gain. FRISKY RICKY chased early inside, moved out on the turn and weakened in the drive. TIZZY lacked a rally. ROCKY ROAD saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. TRIP THE GENERAL chased early, raced in the three path on the turn and tired.
