### Footnotes

SOCRITICAL advanced on the turn, challenged for the lead in the stretch and lugged in some then drew clear. UNCLE DAVE broke a bit slow then moved up along the inside and pressed the issue, reached the front between calls on the turn and battled into midstretch then was no match to the top one while second best. DOUGLASS trailed early and along the inside into the lane, chased then lacked the needed late response. CHIEF TYREE well placed early, chased on the turn and weakened. LAST DIAMOND vied for the lead then bore out turning for home, went wide and was eased up. SPECIAL SALE outside on the turn, raced four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MIDWAY SURF raced near the rail on the turn and tired.
