BULLITONE advanced four wide on the turn and challenged for the lead then responded to urging and edged clear in the drive. PENTECOST trailed and five wide into the lane, finished well while earning the place. BRITEBURG saved ground and vied for command then stayed on willingly while not good enough. SPECTACULARTOP stumbled at the start and up close early, was asked while three wide on the turn and pressed the issue then was not good enough. HEART FEVER between rivals into the turn, moved four wide for the drive and lacked the needed rally. ACOLYTE broke a bit slowly, saved ground into the turn and weakened. REVITALIZE vied for the lead just off the inside and tired through the lane.
