SUN CITY stalked the pace, challenged three across on the turn, swung a bit wide entering the stretch, dueled past the eighth pole and drew off. QUEST FOR JOY was unhurried early, advanced inside around the turn and closed well to get up late for place. A J TANGO was rated early, stalked the pace, challenged between horses on the second turn, dueled past the eighth pole, yielded and was caught for second. WHOS CALLING NOW raced mid pack, bid, hung and failed to menace. FLAWLESS JEWEL raced close to the pace, went eight wide in the drive and failed to rally. CANADIA set the pace, weakened in the drive and faded from contention. AMONG THE WILLOWS was not a factor. CERTAINLY YES was outrun.
