CAPTAIN CANAVERAL set the pace just off the inside and responded to left handed pressure while drawing clear. BOLD BENGIE pressed the issue three wide and was no match late while holding the place. SAX NOTES four wide on the turn, loomed a threat into midstretch then was not good enough. D DEVIL stumbled badly at the start, saved ground and lacked a stretch bid. DEROUIN in the two path on the turn, raced three wide into the lane and lacked the needed bid. CELTIC FABLE away just a bit slowly, pressed early inside and weakened through the lane.
