SMARTY MATT vied for the lead to the lane and gradually edged away through the final furlong. RENEGADE CIELO raced just off the rail turning for home and finished well for the place. WESTERN WALLY vied for the lead inside, chased through the lane and yielded the place late. SNARK stumbled at the start, moved inside on the turn and lacked the needed late response. ENGINEER chased four wide and weakened in the drive. MIGHTY ALL STAR between foes and three wide into the turn, chased and tired in the drive. RIBOMOON raced five wide and lacked the needed bid. DR. POOH broke a bit slowly, saved ground and weakened on the turn.
