AMBEKAY was slow early, advanced through traffic, closed with a rush, got up near the sixteenth pole, drew off and won going away. BOB JILA raced three across early, swung wide leaving the turn, vied to the sixteenth pole and was outclosed to finish second best. WHATA DREAM pressed the pace along the rail, was taken back into the turn, bid gamely and got up for show. ESTANCIA raced between horses early, vied to the sixteenth pole, was unable to sustain his bid and was outfinished for show. TERRELL ME A STORY was never far off the pace, went eight wide in the drive and lacked the needed late rally. QUAKER SHAKER TONY raced in the middle of the pack, failed to rally and did not menace. GOLD COUNTRY lagged early, went eight wide in the drive and lacked a bid. YES TALK TO ME was never far back, bid inside leaving the turn and came up empty. ONE VOTE was not a factor. BAATESH was not a threat.
