ROBBOS COURAGE set the pace and held well in a driving finish. KAMEA raced mid pack, closed steadily, gained late and prevailed for place. OLD MAN RIVER lagged early, angled in entering the stretch, closed along the rail, gained ground and was outfinished for second. CLAIM THE THRONE showed speed around the first turn, fell back, went five wide entering the stretch and closed well. HALO'S HIGHWAY held a good position inside, eased out on the turn, bid and hung. IVES was never far back, went four wide leaving the turn and flattened out. KON KRETE KID saved ground, lacked a bid and was outrun. TARAGE was through early. MY CALL bobbled at the start, failed to contend and distanced the field. MELLO BUT CRAFTY bled and was eased.
