BOB JILA vied outside, took a short lead four across into the turn, was under pressure through the stretch and held on gamely. WILLYCAN raced close to the pace, angled out on the turn, went five wide entering the stretch, went willingly to the wire but didn't have enough to get by. SCARY MIDNIGHT vied between horses, faltered late but held safely for show. MY ROYAL KNIGHT broke out while away alertly, vied inside past the eighth pole and faltered. DEFENSIVE MOVE broke out and bumped at the start, vied outside to the stretch, leveled off and faded. SEA VIPER bumped and was crowded at the start to be off slowly, raced in the back and finished well to narrow the gap. ECHO WEST pressed the pace between horses, was checked hard entering the turn and dropped back. HECTOR was crowded at the start, lacked a bid and was outrun.
