Footnotes

PIVOT PAD was hustled along inside to set a pressured pace, drew off on the turn and extended his lead under mild urging. NOMUDDY'S FOOL pressed the pace three wide between horses to the turn, was no match for the winner and all out for second. RANDOM GENIUS pressed the pace four across to the turn, fell back and was outfinished for place. HALO'S LIMIT raced wide early, dropped inside to save ground, closed through traffic and gained position late. SENATOR MATTY stalked five wide to the turn, went six wide entering the stretch, leveled off and dropped back. COURTING SEATTLE broke in and bumped mildly at the start, pressed the pace while racing between horses to the turn, weakened in the drive and fell back. SOLID TRIP was never far back, offered a mild bid only and failed to menace. TOUCH EM ALL was void of early speed, bid along the rail on the turn to get within striking distance, had nothing left and fell back. ENDED went wide in the drive and failed to respond.
