WARREN'S GUS raced five wide to the turn, lodged his bid nearing the stretch, dueled the length of the stretch and gamely prevailed in the closing strides. TURNAGAIN TAYLOR was four wide moving into contention on the turn, lodged his bid in upper stretch and was slowing gaining on the winner in the late stages but ran out of real estate. AGGRAVATED BATTERY set the pace nursing a narrow lead to the stretch, dueled the winner to the closing strides and gave ground grudgingly late. KUYA broke alertly and forced the pace, fell back some near the quarter pole then weakened some late. MELO was well placed into the turn, raced four wide on the turn then lacked a solid stretch bid. SCARY MIDNIGHT saved ground on the turn, stayed inside for the stretch then lacked a late bid. TUDOR BLUE fell back after the start, was six wide into the stretch and lacked a solid threat. CONDITIONAL settled after the start, took the two path into the stretch and wasn't a factor. MOVE PETER MOVE was between foes then four wide into the stretch and tired.
