CHAMPAGNEFORLUNCH set the early pace, briefly relinquished the lead into the turn, took charge again approaching the quarter pole, widened in upper stretch then held safe a late challenger. EMAN'S PLACE was reluctant to load at the gate, was not far back, came three wide for the drive and finished well to be gaining at the finish. GRAND MALTESE was rushed to the front shortly after the start, took a brief lead into the turn, then weakened in the stretch. VINDICATE IT settled some early, took the three path into the stretch while between foes then lacked a bid. LIMO was five wide much of the way but lacked any solid bid. LOVE YOU BUDDY saved ground on the turn, stayed inside for the stretch and lacked a bid. OTTOMAN took the three path in the stretch but was not a factor. MR. TRENDY was sluggish after the start, was not a factor and trailed throughout while four wide on the turn.
