**Footnotes**

PERFECTIONISM moved up while between foes into the far turn, lodged his bid nearing the stretch and drew off under vigorous left-handed urging. VEGAS TRAIL was four deep down the backstretch while in contention, moved with the winner nearing the quarter pole then couldn't match strides with that one the final furlong while clearly second best. REIGN OF THE EDGE alternated for the lead from the rail, responded nearing the quarter pole then weakened the final furlong. SUNSET KID rated just off the leaders, stayed inside throughout and lacked a stretch bid. DARK INTRIGUE forced the early pace into the first turn, was between foes at the top of the stretch, lacked any bid then was vanned off afterwards. DR. OLIVER broke in the air, raced along the rail throughout and was not a factor. HONEST EARNIE was four wide into the first turn while trying to get position on the pace, alternated for the lead for six furlongs then tired through the stretch. POWER STATION was rated on the first turn, was three deep between into the far turn, was five wide into the stretch and tired.
