**Footnotes**

FIGHTING WONDER vied for the lead from along the rail, took a clear lead nearing the stretch then drew well clear between calls late and was being wound down the final strides. TRIBAL HOMBRE bumped a foe after the start, was four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished well. CONDITIONAL vied for the lead while three deep to the stretch and held on well through the drive. SUMMER SNOW was just off the leaders while in the two path to the stretch, moved to the rail and lacked a solid bid. FINE N' SIZZLING rated off the leaders, was six wide into the stretch and lacked a solid bid. FEAR THE STORM was solidly bumped then stumbled after the start, raced six wide on the turn and lacked any bid. MATUCO (ARG) was near the pace when steadied along the rail passing the half-mile marker, stayed inside and raced a bit erratic in upper stretch and didn't threaten. CLEARLY QUIET vied for the lead and raced between foes to the stretch then tired. FAMOUS FLASH settled after the start, took the three path into the stretch and was not a factor. COLD N TRICKY saved ground but showed little and trailed throughout.
