EDGERIN J was crowded at the start, unhurried early, saved ground, awaited room on the far turn, angled out at the top of the stretch, bid four across, closed steadily and proved best. BRIARTIC COUNTY raced two across to the second turn, vied to the final strides and was outclosed in a game effort. IRON FORTITUDE raced mid pack three across to the second turn, bid five wide, went willingly to the wire but didn't have enough late. DON'T DEFY ME vied past the eighth pole, was unable to sustain his bid and dropped back. MR. WINDSOR raced mid pack inside, rallied around the turn, got through along the rail to challenge, dueled to mid stretch and faltered. BLAST'EM broke in, raced mid pack between horses to the second turn and lacked a bid.
