BROOKIEOFTHEYEAR set the pace, was under pressure through the stretch and held well under left handed urging. COSTA MARTA chased the pace, bid willingly, couldn't gain ground and finished second best. JUMPIN JORDYN was crowded after the start, raced in the back, was roused around the far turn to get within striking distance but came up empty. ISLE DOITFORYOU was never far off the pace while racing inside, had nothing left for the drive and faded from contention. LADY FROM DENVER was outrun in an even effort. LA CORAZON was not a factor. SWAN'S WING appeared to be getting out early, was rated and taken outside, was through early and gave way.
