SPLINDID SUSAN saved ground and drew clear nearing the turn then drew off through the stretch under a mild hand ride. MAYVILLE saved ground and finished steadily while second best. TEE FOR THREE duelled for the early lead between foes, remained a factor into the lane and weakened. DESERT SANDSPOT between rivals early while battling for the lead, dropped back approaching the turn then tired through the lane. YOUR PLACE ANYTIME four deep early, raced five wide turning for home and tired. EMMA CAROLINA lacked a response. MISS NOBLE unseated the rider while fractious in the gate then was scratched.
