Footnotes

BAD BUBBA JONES vied for the lead, took a clear lead into the far turn, widened the advantage into the stretch and was ridden out. HOLD THE ADVANTAGE saved ground on the far turn, stayed along the rail in the stretch and could make little headway late with the rider losing his whip near the sixteenth pole. HEBESMALLBUTMIGHTY moved while five deep down the backstretch, lodged his bid nearing the eighth pole then lacked a solid response. HOPING FOR GOLD was five wide around the far turn and into the stretch and lacked a bid. HIPTOPIA was between foes near the half-mile marker, moved up near the quarter pole then weakened in the drive. MIX was five deep down the backstretch and six wide into the stretch while not a threat. EUGENE'S BOY tried to rate around the first turn, took the two path on the far turn and tired in the drive. TWIN CAM set the pace into the far turn then gave way. YAPPAH DO was four deep down the backstretch, stopped into the stretch and was not asked late.
